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Reus Audio system installed this week 😊 📷

I have been pondering an audio system upgrade for my 00 Boxster S for about the year that I have owned the vehicle but have been lazy about shopping for a new system. The audio system that came with the car is "hi-fi with DSP". I didn't relish the idea of picking out a system piece by piece in the hopes that it would sound impressive when finally installed in the car.

Scott, the owner of La Jolla Audio (here in the San Diego area), who did the install told me about the Reus Audio System. A customer of theirs, Ken Kurr (sp?) was kind enough to stop by with his Boxster and let me listen to the system. The sound is truly angelic.

Once I listened to Ken's system my decision became immensely simpler. Reus system had done all of the engineering and testing for me. To this day, I have no idea how many speakers were put into the vehicle nor what the power output of the system is. It just sounds right.

When I purchased my Boxster, I didn't drive the 6 spd S first. I just knew it would be right and well thought out. The situation is the same with the audio system. The sound is fabulous, just go ahead and put it in.

The system arrived in a huge box with all necessary components inside. The system is what I would describe as "plug and play". The audio system has a "stock" appearance. The head unit is the only thing that stayed the same. If I replace my Boxster with a newer model the system can be removed and put into the new car.

I used to sell stereo equipment for a living about 20 years ago. (For those of you who live in Southern California remember Pacific Stereo?) I feel that I have a "good ear" for sound and listen to my music essentially "flat". The music that comes from the Reus system sounds as though the musicians are sitting on my lap between myself and the airbag as apposed to the factory system where you know the sound is coming from the corners of the windshield. The imaging is unsurpassed.

Thanks again to Scott at La Jolla Audio for recommending the system and for their professional work. I sort of feel like that being an owner of an authentic Reus system is like being part of some sort of secret society-sort of like the original 356 owners were that knew they had something special in an automobile but general public didn't and couldn't understand why anybody would spend as much on their little car as people would ordinarily spend on a Cadillac.

If anyone is in the San Diego area, I would be more than happy to demo the system for you. Bring along your best digitally mastered CD, and we will have some fun.
